- 110 hours of classroom training divided up into four modules:

Our Hospital-Certified, Hospital-Intensive and Internship-Intensive programs share classroom modules, each of which is presented over either a four or three day weekend through either Bucks County Community College, Newtown, PA (every Fall semester) where students are eligible to receive **10 college music credits** upon their completion of the Mastery level; or at of one of our host hospitals (every Spring semester—Spring '06 at The Valley Hospital, Ridgewood, NJ); or in Bensalem, PA (8-week summer intensive for advanced harpists and harpers only). **All classes kept small to assure personalized attention, training, mentorship, support and supervision.**

- 120 hour internship for each level of certification plus 1 contact hour with a Mastery level graduate for every 12 hours you work.

***Hospital-Certified:** If you complete 80% of your internship at one of our unique hospital “incubator” settings, you will receive the designation of Hospital-Certified. (Certifications will read, Hospital-Certified Harp Therapist [HCHT] and Hospital-Certified Master Harp Therapist [HCMHT])

***Hospital-Intensive:** If you complete 50% of your internship at one of our host hospitals, you will receive the designation of Hospital-Intensive. (Certifications will read: Certified Harp Therapist, Hospital Intensive [CHT-HN] and Certified Master Harp Therapist, Hospital Intensive [CMHT-HN])

***Internship-Intensive:** If you work at one of our host hospitals for a minimum of 2 weeks at a minimum of 20 hours per week, you will receive the designation of Internship-Intensive. (Certifications will read: Certified Harp Therapist, Internship Intensive [CHT-TN] and Certified Master Harp Therapist [CMHT-TN])

***All certifications above awarded by Bedside Harp and our host facility.**

At a non-host facility: If you complete your internship at one of our non-host facilities, you will receive the designation(s) of Certified Harp Therapist (CHT) and/or Certified Master Harp Therapist (CMHT) which will be awarded to you by Bedside Harp.
